

Anyone applying for this course needs to be a member of IA and be at least 12 months post completion of surgery. The course is non-qualified, but is endorsed by the Association of Stoma Care Nurses UK and on completion, successful participants will receive an IA Certificate. There is no fee for the course but delegates, or their member organisations, are responsible for their own travelling expenses and we would suggest contacting your member organisation to discuss what financial assistance they may be able to offer, should this be required.
